## WHAT SHOULD CAMPERS BRING?

- Bible
- Pen/pencil
- Towels (for bathing & swimming)
- Jackets or sweatshirts to stay warm
- Shirts, jeans, shorts, extra socks, extra underwear
- Shoes, sandals
- Swimming apparel (trunks for boys and one piece swimsuit for girls)
- Sleeping bag / linens and sheets, pillow
- Toiletries: soap, shampoo, toothbrush & toothpaste
- Flashlight w/ extra batteries
- Insect repellent
- Camera (optional)
- Poncho or umbrella (optional)
- Money for the snack shop and following activities (optional); \$50 maximum
- \$10 for horseback (optional)
- \$12 for single person water tubing (optional)
- \$6/person for doubles water tubing (optional)

*Optional activity costs will be deducted from camper's snack shop account.*

## PLEASE **DO NOT** BRING:

MP3 players, walkie-talkie radios, electronic gaming equipment, magazines, water balloons, water guns, weapons or shaving cream (unless used for intended purpose).

All of these items will be confiscated by the counselors and returned to the camper on the last day of camp.
